* *Students cannot take modules individually at this special price to “build” a degree at IBTS. A maximum of two single modules can be taken virtually or for credit. Not more than 20 ECTS can be obtained in this way. If a third module is taken the full tuition cost for a degree must be paid.*

***If the Student pays Kc 75,000 on Registration with IBTS by 10 September and stays with the discount package then an “Early bird” discount across the total cost of Kc 50,000 will apply, so total fees then payable over the course of the degree will be Kc 330,000 including registration fee but excluding final exam costs.*

Students from CBF Consortium seminaries in the USA doing MDiv degrees or equivalent can attend IBTS for a Trimester and take up to three single modules for credit. There is a registration fee of Kc 5,000 and then a fee per module of Kc 10,000 making a normal total for the Trimester (Autumn or Spring) of Kc 35,000 for tuition.

Exchange students under the Erasmus programme should consult the Registrar for details of Erasmus conditions.

These fees are correct for those applying for the 2012-2013 Academic year and include tuition, course handbook and workbooks, library admission. They do not include accommodation and food, which are charged separately, as required. There is a discount for those paying fees in advance or by 10 September. Those not maintaining payment pattern will, of course, have to pay any higher tuition fee imposed in subsequent years of study after their registration.
